- 2) "Dark Life of Transgender in Pakistan and Necessary Solutions" (Ms. Sunnya Abbasi, transgender teacher at the Gender Guardian School)

Keeping that in view, Ms. Iffat Khalid from the Department of Humanities arranged an open discussion forum on "Age of Curiosity-Struggling Youth" on 17th October 2019 in

Dr. Musferah Mehfooz (Assistant Professor, Islamic Studies) was invited as a guest speaker to deliver a talk about "Necessity of Inquiry Based Education System in Muslim World" by Physics Department, CUI, Lahore Campus on November 29, 2019. She discussed that inquiry based education instills the willingness to explore new ideas based on evidence and logic. She was of the view that this system is still not



well recognized in the Islamic world, may be due to reluctance to change in the society and disinclination of governments. Islamic countries should capture the opportunities and expand applying inquiry based education programs at primary, secondary and tertiary levels.

CONTEMPORARY TRENDS IN LANGUAGE AND LITERARY RESEARCH
